

## AUTHOR STATEMENT

**1. The Authors, hereby confirming that they have carefully read and applied the Guidelines prior to submitting their work,**

**a) declare that**

- they adhere to the ethical standards published in the Journal website;
- the work which is submitted to Urbino University Press (henceforth UUP), in final form so as to exclude any correction or change in proof, is of their exclusive property and does not contain anything which violates any third party's copyright or other rights;
- the text is accompanied by authorization for reproduction by UUP if any of its contents is copyrighted to a third party; the authors undertake to hold the publisher free from liability for any claim that may be advanced by third parties, also undertaking to pay compensation for any damage suffered by the Publisher resulting from unauthorized reproductions;

**b) authorize UUP to publish the work** (if accepted) online on the UUPJ platform; after revision and correction of the drafts to be performed exclusively by the editors of the Journal.

**c) agree to and accept the following paragraphs (2-8):**

**2. Only uncopyrighted figures** can be reproduced, that is, if they are in the public domain or accompanied by permission from the rights holder. Such permission is to be provided when submitting the work to be published. Images from the Internet always require authorization except when the source declares otherwise. The sources of what is reproduced from other publications must always be acknowledged. No work with copyright permission pending will be accepted.

**3. The copyright** of the contents is maintained by the individual Authors or (in the event of an agreement between the parties independent of the Publisher) by the commissioning Journals or Scientific Structures). The publication does not imply any transfer of copyright by the Authors to the Publisher. The Authors simply authorize the publication under a Creative Commons "Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives 4.0 International (CC BY-NC-ND)" license. Authors maintain the whole copyright of their texts, while the editorial format and the graphical layout of the works published by UUP remain the latter's exclusive property. Their contents may be published at any time and in any form with another publisher, with the following limitations: the new publication must cite the references of the previous publication under the UUP trademark, including the URL of the online publication; the new publication must not exclude nor limit the continuation of publication of the work by UUP in any way.

It is allowed to upload the whole published files only to institutional officially recognized repositories, established and operated by universities and governments. The authors acknowledge that in the hypothesis of inserting the files on personal and/or research websites, the publication must be reported accompanied by the abstract, the DOI code, and the title page of the Journal issue.

**7. Peer-review** policy and procedure. *Lingua &* - *Rivista di lingue e culture moderne* is a double blind peer-reviewed journal. Exceptionally, invited articles will also be published. In submitting their works, authors agree that these may be published (if accepted). Submission of a work does not ensure acceptance. Works will be evaluated by at least two reviewers, according to whose indications they will be either accepted, returned to the authors for corrections, or rejected. The final decision is the responsibility of the General Editor and will be taken within four months of receipt.

**8.** In case of multiple authors, the Corresponding Author will handle all correspondence with the Journal editors.
